

CUPP PunkThis Android running Windows 7 and Gingerbread

PunkThis could say that a device is unique in its kind, this is a notebook that can combine two different x86 and ARM platforms on a single computer. The device is built with two motherboards, a DM3730 ARM CPU Texas Instruments with 512 MB of RAM which is in charge of running Android 2.3 Gingerbread and another driven by the current Atom processor in charge of Windows 7.

The change of SO occurs only with a combination of keys and so fast we can choose between Android and Windows, also includes Wi-Fi, USB, external video connector and two slots for SD, one of them to keep the OS of AMR platform (Android) and another to exchange between the two OSes.
